## DESCRIPTION

This course aims to provide teachers with practical tools and strategies for student-centered learning by delving into the various teaching methods: Waldorf, Free Learning, Nachbarschaft and Montessori. Participants will have the opportunity to visit these schools and learn about their principles and practices, as well as how to incorporate them into their own teaching. Through practical activities, group work and discussions, participants will gain a deeper understanding of student-centered learning and how it can be implemented in the classroom.

- Understand the principles and practices of student-centered learning
- Incorporate student-centered learning into lesson plans and curriculum
- Get to know the Waldorf, Free Learning, Nachbarschaft and Montessori methodologies and their methodologies
- Develop practical tools and strategies for implementing student-centered learning
- Reflect on personal teaching practices and how to improve them

- Outdoor activity to practice student-centered learning in a non-classroom setting

- Exploration of Leipzig
