BOARD GAMES AND STEAM EDUCATION: INNOVATIVE STRATEGIES FOR TEACHING AND LEARNING

DESCRIPTION

This course focuses on exploring the use of board games as an effective teaching tool for STEAM education (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics). Participants will learn about the benefits of using board games in STEAM education, how to integrate them into their curriculum, and how to create their own STEAM-based board games. Through hands-on activities and group discussions, participants will learn how to engage and motivate students in STEAM subjects using board games.

LEARNING **OUTCOMES**

- Understand the benefits of using board games in STEAM education
- Identify how to integrate board games into STEAM curriculum
- Connect board games to practice STEAM skills, including problemsolving, critical thinking, and creativity
- Create a STEAM-based board game
- Evaluate the effectiveness of using board games in STEAM education

- Hands-on activity: prototyping and playtesting the board game

- Hands-on activity: continuing the work on creating a STEAM-based board game
- Peer feedback and evaluation of board games
